2. You can enter the competition up to midnight on 16th October to allow us to send you the competition details.
3. All submissions for the competition will need to be emailed. Remember – your entry will be viewed from every angle, so we will need you to submit approx. 10 photos to show every angle of your bake. We will need short videos to show you putting in your bake and one of you taking it out of the oven. You will be sent a Drop Box link and you will need to submit your entry by 7pm on 18th October 2020.
4. Each category of entrant will have a designated judge, and their decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
5. The winners will be announced at 6pm on 21st October 2020.
6. We will only use the information you provide in your entry to enable us to process your entry fee, to contact you in relation to the competition, and in ways outlined in our privacy notice. Please see our website for more detail:
